The Montana Medical Association is pleased to share the 2011 Legislative Scorecard for the 62<sup>nd</sup> session of the Montana Legislature. The scorecard is a review of prioritized health care issues addressed during the session that focused on preserving the physician/patient relationship, maintaining access to care, and ensuring patient safety.

The number of health care related bills appeared to have hit an all time high which is notable and reflective of the importance of the issue to Montanans. The MMA is the voice for physicians during these debates and many physician members worked diligently to ensure that voice was heard throughout the 88-day session.

The intent of the scorecard is to inform physician members of how their state legislators voted overall on bills that were of most importance to physicians and their patients. The bills selected to be listed on the scorecard are reflective of where the MMA focused most of its efforts during the session: tort reform, workers' compensation reform, patient safety and health care access.

Points were assigned based on the importance of the bill. A bill assigned a higher point value would have greater importance. Points were assigned based on the final vote on the bill. Points were also assigned to the committee votes. Legislators were given a point if their committee vote supported the MMA position. For committees, a vote against the MMA position resulted in a loss of a point.

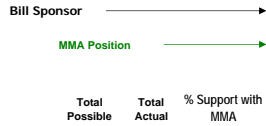

These legislators aligned with the MMA position over 80% of the time or assisted the MMA with a commitment to working for the common of all patients and physicians.
